## IR. JOOST VOS

Joost Vos (1972, Arnhem) graduated as engineer from the Faculty of Architecture at Delft University of Technology in 1996. In 1997 he started his career as an architect in Amsterdam, at first at Greiner van Goor Architecten, then at Benthem Crouwel Architects in the same year. In 2005 Joost Vos became a partner at the office. He is a member of the Royal Institute of Dutch Architects (bna).

Over the years Joost has been project architect for infrastructure projects, cultural buildings, urban design master plans, housing, office and university buildings. Next to impressive projects as the Anne Frank Museum, the Grotiusbuilding for the Radboud University Nijmegen and the master plan for Amsterdam Central station, Joost is often responsible for projects involving complex steel constructions such as the Stedelijk Museum Amsterdam, the fourth roof of Amsterdam Central Station, the Wilo office building and the Datacenter AM3.

Joost Vos has given public lectures in the Netherlands and abroad, including Amsterdam, Delft, Eindhoven New Dehli (India) and Weimar (Germany).
