

CURRICULUM VITAE

Daniel Jongtien has always been fascinated by buildings. He is particularly interested by how they contribute to the city and how people use and experience them. The buildings that Benthem Crouwel Architects designs are a perfect combination of technology, expression, creativity and functionality. This approach leads to innovative and surprising architecture.

At Benthem Crouwel Architects he mostly works on large and compelling projects. Overseeing their complexity and urban impact has now become one of his strongest points. The projects are large team tasks in which a group achievement is made. Many of them have a great social relevance, which makes working on them especially rewarding.

The architecture of these projects is created by a group of architects rather than one individual. Benthem Crouwel Architects functional and rational buildings go beyond the obvious and are always surprising and innovative. The studio works on a broad range of projects, yet our knowledge and expertise in the field of transit projects is unrivalled.

Daniel graduated with honours as architect from the Faculty of Architecture at the Delft University of Technology in 2002. He started his career at Netherlands Airport Consultants (NACO) by working on Amsterdam Airport Schiphol and many other international airports. In 2006 he joined Benthem Crouwel Architects as an architect, and became partner at the firm in 2017.

Daniel Jongtien has extensive working experience in long-term, complex, public (transport) projects such as Amsterdam Airport Schiphol, Station Amsterdam Centraal, Delft Station; and currently three new metro stations in Paris and the Diridon multimodal hub in San Jose, CA. He is known for his rational approach to design. Daniel greatly values the involvement of clients and stakeholders during the design process. He strives to create balance and team spirit in the design teams he leads.

Daniel Jongtien is a member of the Royal Institute of Dutch Architects (bna).

He has given international lectures in particular on the subject of transit in China, Canada, America and various European countries.
